ACCESS for English Language Learners & Alternate ACCESS for ELLs	ACCESS: K – 12 Alt. ACCESS 1-12	Jan. 16 - March 8, 2024	Students must have been screened and identified as English Learners to be eligible for ACCESS assessment participation. Only ELs identified as a student with the most significant cognitive disabilities are assigned to the Alternate ACCESS for ELLs.
SAT School Day Math, Evidence-based Reading and Writing with no separate essay	11 and 12 ¹	March 18 - April 26, 2024	The new digital SAT allows for a longer testing window than in previous years. LEAs will have the flexibility to set a shorter testing window locally. There will be no makeup window. All testing will be administered digitally, except in such cases that a student must test on paper as an accommodation per their IEP.
NM-Assessment of Science Readiness (ASR)	5, 8, 11, 12 ¹	March 11 - May 10, 2024	This year, the ASR is being administered on the Kite testing platform, the same platform used to administer the DLM assessment; the test blueprint, scale and PLDs remain the same.
Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM)	3 – 8, 11, 12 ¹ ELA/Math 5, 8, 11, 12 ¹ Science		Designed exclusively for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities who have been identified as an “Alternate Assessment” participant in the IEP. The PED highly recommends beginning testing early in the window.
New Mexico Measures of Student Success and Achievement (MSSA) Math, ELA, SLA	3 – 8	March 25 - May 10, 2024	LEAs have the flexibility to schedule these assessments in a way that best fit its needs. All sessions are untimed. The approximate time required to complete the math assessment is 120 minutes; ELA or SLA 150 minutes; and 150-165 minutes for Science.
